

DURING THE YEAR 2014-15
MAIN ACTIVITIES OF THE COUNCIL FOR DEVELOPMENT OF
POOR AND LABOURERS (CDPL), LILONG IMPHAL, MANIPUR.

Embroidery / Tailoring & Knitting Cum Production Programme :

This year also the organization has performed 6 (six) month Vocational Training programme on Embroidery, Tailoring & Knitting from 1st April to 2nd Oct 2014 at Office Premises. In this training programme 156 females and 87 male who belong to below property line are participated. 43 nos of women belonging to minority communities aged between 15 to 45 years are also participated. The trainees of the Council produced various kinds of Embroidery, Tailoring & Knitting garments. These production are marketed with marginal price with these production the Council is able to earn a small income.

Computer / Typing Training :

The CDPL has organized 3(three) Months Certificate Course in Office Autonomous and Internet, 6 (six) Months Certificate in Computer Operation and Application (CCOA), CCA, Certificate in Web Technology (SWT), Certificate in Multimedia and Animation Designing , C++, Certificate Course in Application Software(CAS) and 1(one) years course i.e. PGDCA, DCPA, HDCA, DCTT under affiliation to AISCET Bhopal, in the name of Bhagerat Institution and Information and Technology (BIIT), Singjamei Chingmakhong, Traffic Point Imphal. In this different courses 350 nos of Student are participated. 45 nos of Minority women are also participated for this computer training programme for the empowerment and development of minority women.

Free Coaching Programme for Minority Students

As continued from the past years, this year the Council for Development of Poor and Labourers (CDPL), Lilong has also conducted 3(three) Batch Free Coaching programme for Pre-Medical and Pre-Engineering for 3 (three) months for the Students belonging to ST/SC and Other Backward class student and Minority Communities of the state of Manipur commencing from 1st April to 30th June 2014 for 1st Batch, 1st July to 30th Sept. for 2nd Batch and 1st October to 30th December 2014 for the 3rd Batch at Singjamei Chingamakhong. For this purpose, the organization has widely notified in the daily Local News Paper. In a Batch 100 nos of student are Coached for 3 Batch i.e 300 student are coached in this year.

Special School for Disable person.

The Council for Development of Poor and Labourers (CDPL) has been continued the Special School for Disable Persons / Students at Langthabal P.O. Lilong in the name of “ **Brother Physically Handicapped School**”. In this year 150 nos of Students are learned from different area of Manipur and 15 trained teaching Staff and 13 Non-Teaching Staff are serving. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs, Govt. of India has recommended / sanctioned for expenditure of 50 students and 12 staff.

Vocational Training for Disable Persons

The Vocational Training programme for Disable Persons was started in the year 2006 and till then this programme has been continued at Langthabal Kunja, Imphal West District, Manipur. In this year the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs, Govt. of India has sanctioned to organized vocational training for disable persons. In this training programme 150 nos of disable persons are participated in different trade. i.e Embroidery & Wool Kitting Training, Carpentry Training and Cane and Bamboo work Training from 1st April 2014 to 31st March 2015.

Second Chance Camp

The Council has organized 4 (four)Months Second Chance Camp under the Scheme National Programme for Youth and Adolescent Development under the financial assistance of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Govt. of India, New Delhi from 21st April 2014 to 20th August 2014 at Lilong Youth Centre. In the Inaugural function of the Camp with Shri N.G. Motilal Singh, District Youth Affairs and Sports Officer, Imphal West District, Government of Manipur, Shri W. Bankimchandra Singh, Chairperson, Lilong Nagar Panchayat, Imphal West District and Shri Dr. Kunjabihari Singh, Vice-Principal, Lilong Higher Secondary School, Lilong as Chief Guest, President and Guest of Honour respectively.

In the said Camp 12 (Twelve) Resources Persons are delived their Valuable Speech on different Topic. The Closing function of the camp was held on 20th August with Shri N. Dhaneshor Singh, Councilor Ward No.5, Lilong Nagar Panchayat, Imphal West District and Shri M.Loken Singh, President of the Organisation as a Chief Guest and President respectively.

Residential School for Schedule Caste Students

The CDPL, Lilong has been running a Residential School for Schedule Caste Students at Lilong Chajing Mamang Leikai, Imphal West District, Manipur in the name of the "***Apollo International School***". In this year 150 nos of Schedule Caste Students are teaching in Free of Course.

Food Preservation Training Programme

The Council has arranged the fermentation of dry fish i.e. "Ngari" in Manipuri. The 18th January 2015 the Council has conducted a training programme for making "Ngari" at Langthabal, Imphal West District, Manipur. In this training programme 135 nos of trainee are participated.

Craft Training Centre :

The Council organized 6 (six) month Craft Training Center (Kouna Crfat) at Lilong Bazar from 2nd June to 1st Nov. 2014. In this programme 123 youths including 67 females who are belonging to below poverty line are participated. The craft products are sale at the Market and earn their own livelihood.

Drug Abuse & Intervention programme

The Council for Development of Poor and Labourers (CDPL) Lilong Imphal Manipur has organized one day Anti Drug Campaign on the 23rd Sept 2013 at Hiyangthang with the participation of 250 youths. In this training programme 123 women are participated belonging to Minority Communities and 67 nos are schedule caste youth and women. In this training programme Dr. Ksh.Radheshyam Singh, Retd. District Family Welfare Officer, Thoubal and W. Gonendra Singh , Social Worker, has deliver their valuable Speech about the Drug Abuse and Healthy Society.

Destitute Home :

The Council already open a Destitute Home for Children and Women in affected HIV/AIDS, Communal riot Victims and Orphan Children at Lilong Chajing Awang leikai, P.O. Lilong Imphal West District, Manipur.

Environment Awareness programme

The Organisation has Observed the World Environment Day on of 5th June 2014 at Regional College, Lilong. In this function Dr. Th. Sobita Devi, Lecturer, D.M. College of Science, Imphal and O. Opendro Singh, Social worker is as Resource Person. In this Programme 110 nos of youth are participated. In this training programme 46 nos of minority women are also participated.

Awareness Programme for youth and Adolescent :

The organisation has conducted one day awareness programme for youth and adolescent development programme at Kakwa Bazar, Imphal West District, Manipur in the theme of Youth is the building of Nation. In this awareness programme 4 (four) resource persons are speech their valuable and important point share to the youth of Manipur. This programme 230 youth are participant.
